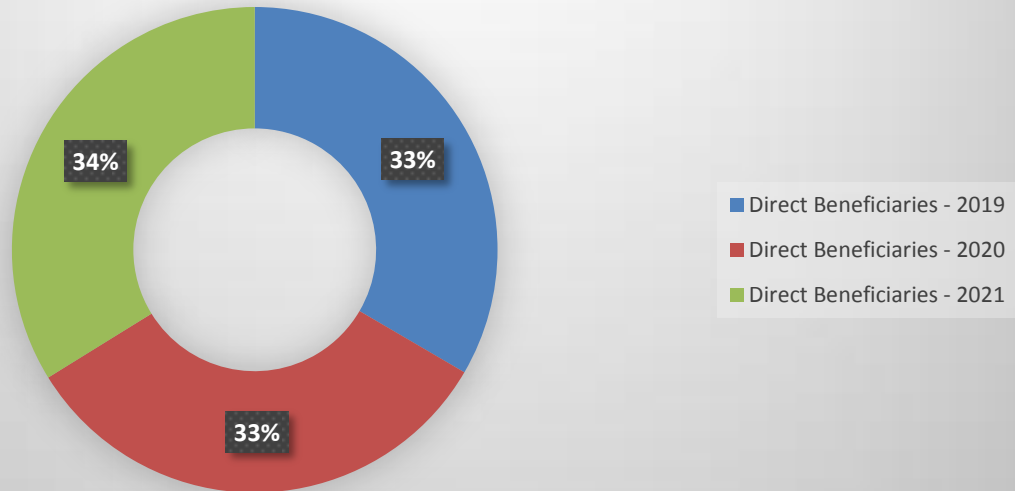

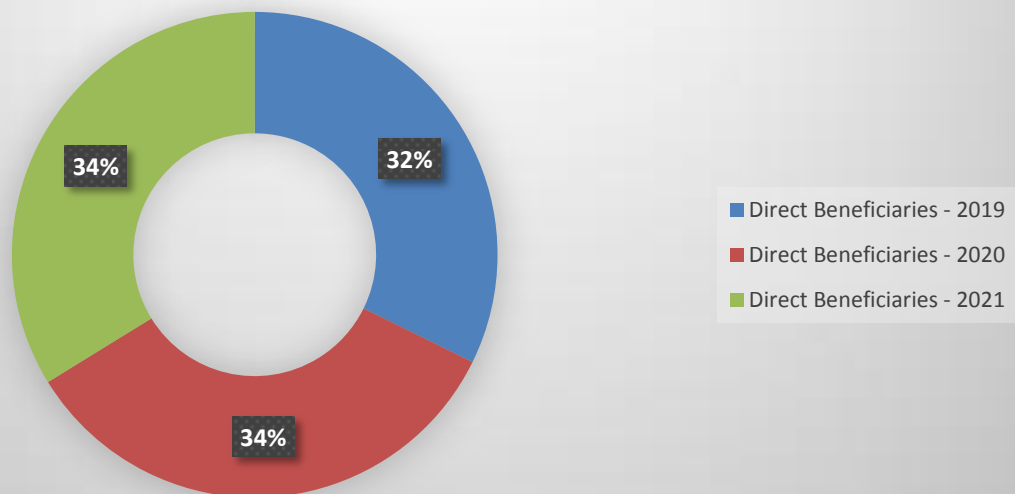

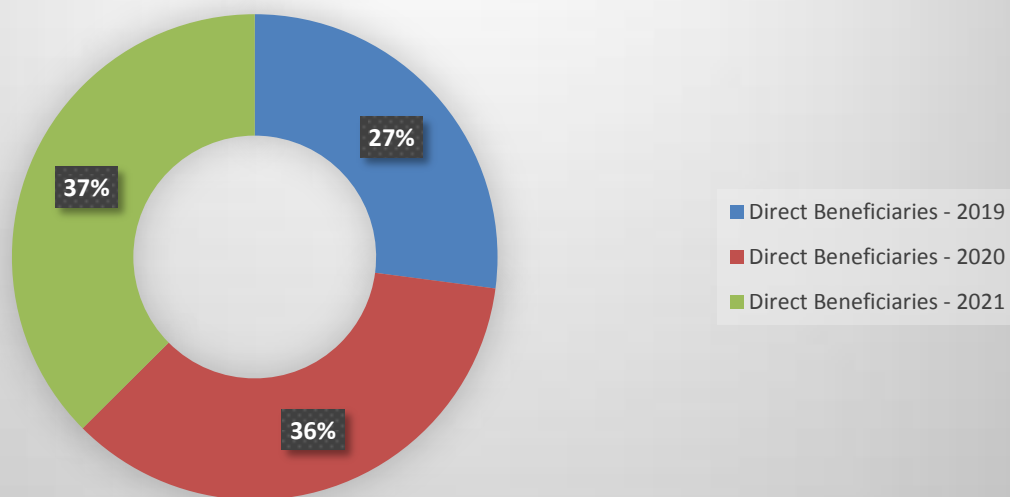


Strategic Pillar -2 Development Aid



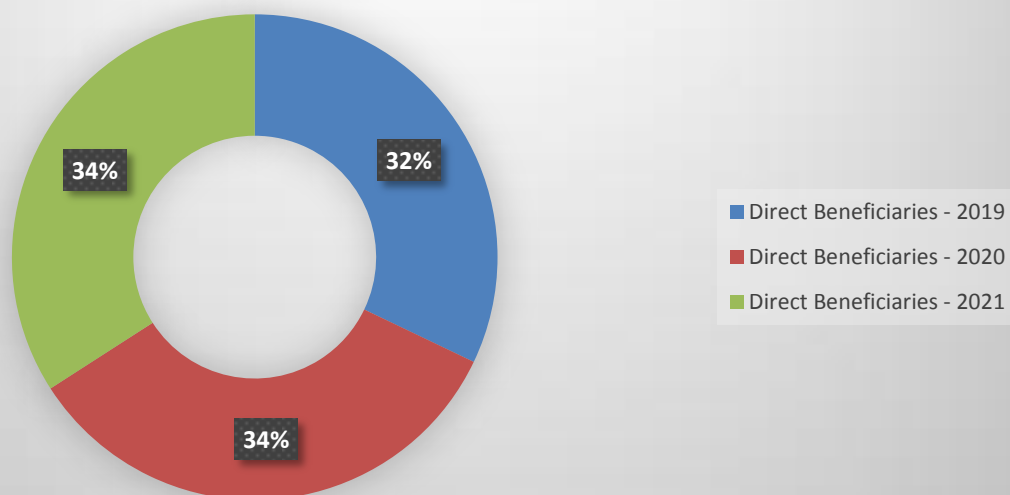

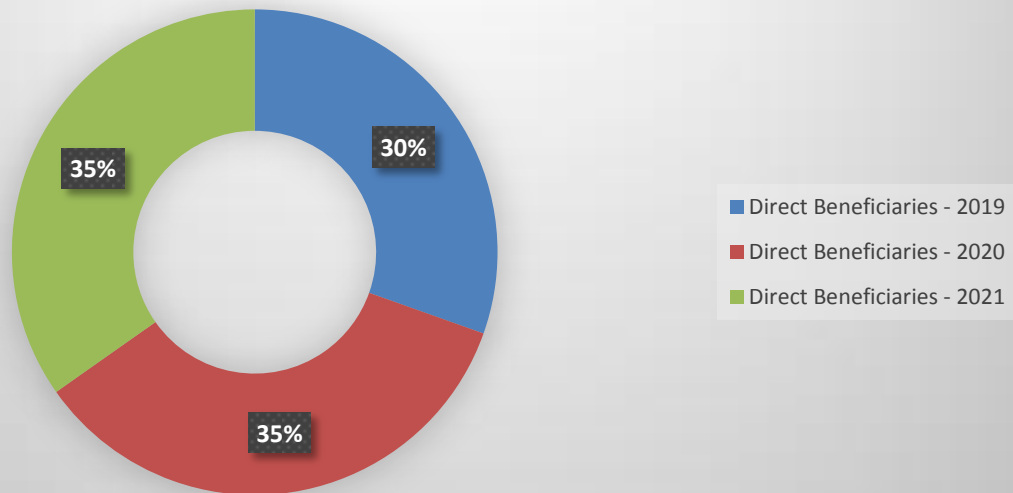
